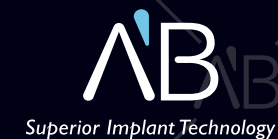

Arrival to Israel

June 7 - Sunday

Massada, Dead Sea

June 9 - Tuesday

Early departure from Ashdod (08:00 a.m.). Drive to the Judean Desert and on to Massada, the site of the Zealots last stand against the Romans that was originally built as a magnificent palace for Herods the Great. We will ascend by cable car to observe impressive construction, the beautiful mosaics, the synagogue, a bathhouse and a Byzantine Church. Descend by cable car. Drive to the Dead Sea and enjoy this magnificent floating experience in the lowest point on Earth. Drive through the Judean Desert and the Good Samaritan Inn to Jerusalem, arrival to the hotel for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.



Jerusalem

June 10 - Wednesday

After breakfast, drive for a spectacular panoramic overlook of the Old City from the Mount of Olives. Walk down hill to the Kidron Valley and enter the Garden of Gethsemane, the Church of All Nations, also called the Basilica of Agony. We will enter the Old City through one of its ancient gates, then proceed to the Wailing Wall – the remnant of Solomon’s Temple – and touch its ancient stones. View the Temple Mount with the Dome of the Rock, the Via Dolorosa and the Arab Market. We will visit the Holy Sepulchre – the largest Church in Jerusalem. On to the Jewish Quarter, where we will see the renovated Cardo (the once main north-south colonnaded Roman Street) and its excavations. On to the Jewish Quarter and Mount Zion to visit David’s Tomb, the Room of the Last Supper and the Church of the Dormition. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.



Jerusalem

June 11 - Thursday

We will start the morning, after breakfast, visiting Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Memorial. We will continue to Ein Karem to visit the Church of St. John the Baptist. On to the Israel Museum and the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea Scrolls can be seen, visit the Model of Jerusalem showing the city as it was. Afterwards drive to the birth place of Jesus – Bethlehem. We will visit the Church of Nativity and the Shepherd’s Fields. We

will have a Farewell dinner in a restaurant outside the hotel. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

Nazareth, Tel Aviv

June 12 - Friday

Early breakfast and departure to Nazareth where we visit the Church of the Annunciation, and the Synagogue where Jesus learnt to read the Bible. We drive pass Cana of Galilee, the village where Jesus performed his first miracle –the miracle at the wedding to the Sea of Galilee. Visit Capernaum, the “Town of Jesus”, walk along the ruins of this Biblical village, and see the synagogue where Jesus preached and the house of Peter’s mother-in-law. Drive up to Mount of the Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the Sermon of the Mount. Visit the beautiful mosaic floor at Tabgha, the site of the miracle of the multiplication. Proceed to Yardenit, the baptismal site and drive to Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight in the hotel.



Free Day

June 13 - Saturday

After breakfast, you will have day free for personal activities. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Back Home

June 14 - Sunday

At a determined time transfer to Ben Gurion Airport.
